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БОЛГАРСКОЕ БОДАКОВ
И ЭТИМОЛОГИЧЕСКОЕ ГНЕЗДО С КОРНЕМ *BOD-

[Bulgarian *Bodakov* and Etymological Cluster with the Root **bod-*]

Abstract: The article discusses the reconstruction of the word-building microsystem with the root **bod-*. The analysis of the available factual material enabled the reconstruction of over 60 Proto-Slavic archetypes with this root which considerably expands the scope of the respective etymological nest as it is represented in the Etymological dictionary of the Slavic languages and in Słownik prasłowiański. On the basis of the new factual material (both appellative and proprial) the following dictionary entries were expanded: **bodačъ*, **bodakъ*, **bodadlo*, **bodunъ*, **bodarъ* etc.

Part of the lexical archaisms were fossilized and survived only within the proprial part of the language system (personal names and place names) which confirms the expedience of the idea that has been more than once proposed previously of including nomina propria as the illustrative material into the etymological dictionaries of the Proto-Slavic lexical antiquities.
