He was born on November 12, 1972, in Sisak, Croatia. In 1999 he obtained a M.A. in general linguistics and comparative literature at the Faculty of Arts and Humanities, University of Zagreb. From October 1998 to June 1999, as a graduate student, he collaborated in the first phase of creating the *Croatian National Corpus* at the Department of Linguistics of the Faculty of Arts and Humanities, University of Zagreb.

From October 2000 to January 2006, he was employed at the Sisak High School, and after that, from February 2006, at the Institute for Croatian Language and Linguistics.

In 2008 he obtained the title of senior expert associate in the Department of General, Comparative and Computational Linguistics (now the Department of General Linguistics). From 2006 until 2010, he was a junior expert associate within projects *Croatian Language Repository* and *Semantic Networks and Computational Lexicology* (PI dr. sc. Damir ćavar, financed by Ministry of Science and Education, Republic of Croatia). From 2010 he was a senior expert associate within the program *Development of Croatian Special Field Terminology – Struna* (PI dr. sc. Maja Bratanić, financed by the Croatian National Foundation for Science). Since June 2013, he's also a senior expert associate within the project *Valency Base of Croatian Verbs (e-Glava)*, and from 2020 within the project *Syntactic and Semantic Analysis of Arguments and Adjuncts in Croatian – SARGADA* (PI dr. sc. Matea Birtić, financed by the Croatian National Foundation for Science).
